- The minutes of the previous meeting were confirmed.
- 2. It was reported that, since 30-40% teaching is to be covered through online mode, the teachers have been asked to plan and prepare the e content. 30-40% teaching of theory papers will be done through online mode. Google classroom will be used as a platform to upload the e content prepared by the teachers.

Practical will be conducted in the laboratory, which may be taught in smaller groups.

Action Taken: Online classes are being conducted by all teachers. Google class room is used as a platform with Google Meet or Zoom. A detailed record of the online classes and e-content is maintained by the teachers. This is submitted as a weekly work from home report to IQAC and the Principal.

- 3. A series of Online Yoga Sessions was organized in association with Swaroop Yog Sadhana Kendra, Pune in the month of April and May. The recorded videos of **Yoga aasans** were shared with the students and staff twice in a week. The students were asked to share their photos while performing **Asanas** on an email specially created for the same. Smt. Pranjali Fadnavis, Yoga Therapist, was the resource person.
- 4. A qualified psychological counsellor, Smt. Pallavi Inamdar was appointed to counsel the students who were under mental stress during lock down period. Her contact number was shared with the students through official WhatsApp groups.
- 5. TSAD department and IQAC jointly organized Online Madhubani Painting Workshops in two batches on 9th June and 12th June 2020. It was attended by 70 first year students. This will be followed by a series of workshops on different themes.

Action Taken: A series of online workshops and value added courses have been planned and conducted for students by the Skill Chain committee and IQAC.
