Minutes of the meeting:

1. The minutes of the previous meeting were confirmed.
2. It was reported that a new PG degree program M.Sc. Clinical Nutrition & Dietetics had been sanctioned. Additional batch of M.Sc. Nutrition & Food Processing and additional batch of FY BSc Nutrition & Dietetics had also received sanction.

Action Taken: Admission to all these programs have started.

3. The proposal for MSc Biodiversity - Conservation and Management has been submitted to the university. It is likely to be sanctioned for academic year 2021-22.

Action Taken: A regular follow up regarding the proposal for MSc Biodiversity - Conservation and Management is done. The course structure and syllabus for the same has been approved by the BOS and Faculty of Science & Technology at university level.

4. The report and status of online admission process for the UG and PG programs was given to the members.
5. Details of online teaching were given. All permanent teaching faculty have been conducting online lectures from 1st August 2020. Teachers had submitted a lecture for approval and suggestions of Principal madam and E content committee before commencing the online classes.

Action Taken: Detailed records of online classes are maintained by teachers. Weekly records are mailed to IQAC and Principal every Saturday.

6. Three permanent teaching faculty (Dr. S Zambre, Smt. A Machhe, Smt. R Nanaware) and one non-teaching staff (Smt. B Aru) had recently retired from college.

Action Taken: Visiting faculty has been appointed on clock hour basis for aided programs and on consolidated basis for unaided programs.

- vii. Observing Gandhi Jayanti on October 2, 2020.
- viii. Celebration of VachanPrernaDiwas on October 15, 2020
- ix. Certificate courses in Women's Studies (30 hours) and Soft Skills (50 hours)

Action Taken: Value added workshops have been conducted for students. Orientation of "Searching E Resources" & "Presentation Skills" for TY BSc students, "Cyber Security" for FY & SY BSc students.
