- **To conduct 'Deeksharambha' and other Orientation Programs**

→ An orientation program for FY B. Sc. students was organized on 10<sup>th</sup> July 2023. The Principal, Prof Sachin Deore welcomed the students and briefed about the history of the University and College. He further gave an overview about the co-curricular and extra-curricular activities of students could participate for the overall holistic development. He also briefed the students about the National Education Policy and the preparedness of the college towards its implementation.

→ Principal, Prof. Sachin Deore oriented the students on National Education Policy and Academic Bank of Credits on 27<sup>th</sup> July 2023.

→ An orientation program for FY J C was arranged on 12<sup>th</sup> August 2023.

→ The Deeksharambha was inaugurated on Monday, 4<sup>th</sup> September 2023. This program was an orientation for F.Y. B.Sc. and F.Y M. Sc. students. Prof. Sachin Deore (Principal, Addl. Charge), Dr. Vrushali Nagarale (Admission Committee In-charge), Mrs. Madhuri Ratnaparkhi (IQAC Coordinator) and admission committee members arranged the activities for the Deeksharambha program. The weeklong Deeksharambha program, (from 4<sup>th</sup> September to 9<sup>th</sup> September 2023) included lectures and visits to the colleges in the SNTD Women's University Campus, Pune.

- **To conduct Add on and Value-Added sessions, seminars, field visits and guest lectures to enrich the curriculum**

→ A seminar on 'Basics of Vastushatra' was arranged by Resource Management department for TY Interior Space Design students on 11<sup>th</sup> October 2023. Ms. Rituja Tulshi, an alumna of the department was the resource person.

→ A visit to Timber Market was arranged by Resource Management department for TY Interior Space Design students on 13<sup>th</sup> October 2023 to give exposure to various finishing materials used in Interior Designing.

→ A visit to 'Hotel Kohinoor Executive' was arranged by Resource Management department for TY HECS students for giving a practical know how of working of the Front Office Desk on 16<sup>th</sup> October 2023.

→ A session on Coping up with perceived stress was held on 7<sup>th</sup> March 2024 for the students of M.Sc. Clinical Nutrition and Dietetics and M.Sc. Nutrition and Food Processing. The guest speaker was Dr. Ujjwal Nene, who is a Clinical Psychologist with many decades of experience. She talked to the students about what stress is and how to cope up with the same.
